Campers learn through fun, interactive experiences, labs, and activities. Science Explorers teaches science to children in a safe, encouraging environment. Campers are urged to ask questions, move around, and communicate with one another. They will learn while having a great time! Camp is open to grades 1-5.

Week 1: Nature– Learn all about plants, animals, and the environment.

Week 2: Force and Motion- Learn about force, what makes things change their motion, and simple machines. You will even create your own machines!

Week 3: “Out of this World” Science– This week will focus on space science with “Out of This World” activities!

Week 4: Wacky Weather– Learn about and recreate weather phenomenon.

Week 5: Food Science– Use food to demonstrate a wide range of scientific concepts.

Week 6: Forensics Lab– Learn all about forensics and find out “Whodunit” by using what you learned to solve the crimes.

Week 7: Earth Science– Discover everything from what our atmosphere is made of to how mountains are formed!

Week 8: Chemistry– Use fun experiments to demonstrate different chemical processes!
